A RECYCLING GUIDE FOR BUSINESSES WITHIN THE CITY OF SPOKANE

CREATE A SEPARATE RECEPTACLE FOR EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:



PAPER



Recycle: Newspaper, magazines, phone books, cardboard, computer paper, ledger paper, paper bags, junk mail, faxes, colored paper, brochures, catalogues, cereal boxes, copy paper, reports, notebooks, paperback books, paper egg cartons, soft drink boxes, post-its, & paper towel tubes.

Don't Recycle: Pizza Boxes, food contaminated boxes, waxed paper, tissue, paper towels, & carbon paper.

GLASS

- Glass may be brown, green or clear.
- Rinse and remove lids.
- Labels may be left on.
- DON'T include drinking glasses or window glass, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics.



ALUMINUM/TIN/PLASTIC



- The City of Spokane Solid Waste Management accepts type 1 (PETE) & 2 (HDPE) uncolored plastic. All plastic is labeled somewhere on the container to show the type.
- Throw the lids in the trash.
- Peel labels if possible.
- Rinse any residue.
- NO plastic bags or aluminum foil
