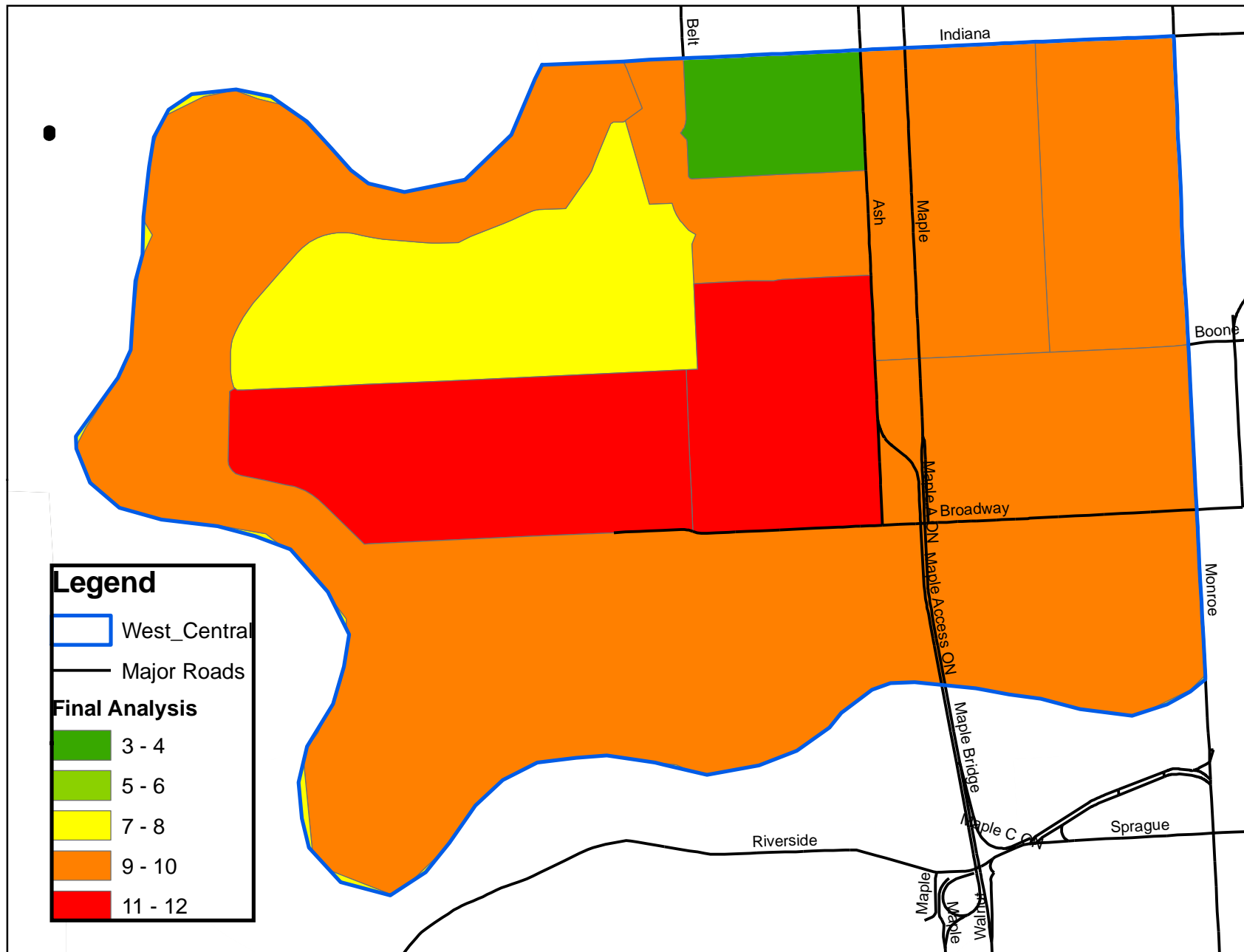


# Total Risk Assessment for Elevated Blood Lead Levels



The risk assessment for elevated blood lead levels looks at families in poverty, median household income and number of children under the age of 5. These individual risk parameters were ranked on a scale of 1 to 4 and then added together (over the entire city and census block group levels) to develop the overall risk assessment
