The Great Spokane CFL Change Out Caper

The Northwest Climate Change Center (NWCCC) is excited about announcing its new initiative: The Great Spokane CFL Change Out Caper. NWCCC will be working in cooperation with the City of Spokane and Avista with the design of the program. Spokane Neighborhood Councils are invited to participate. The program intent is to offer participating Spokane Avista electric customers one free CFL in exchange for the removal of an incandescent light bulb and placement of the CFL (Compact Fluorescent Lamp).

- Spokane Neighborhood Councils (27)
 - NWCCC will implement the CFL distribution program.
 - Up to 200 CFLs (direct shipped) will be provided by Avista. Additional product (direct shipped) will be available for purchase at Avista's discounted cost. Energy efficiency educational materials will be provided by Avista to participating neighborhood organizations. Avista may substitute product, with program support, up to an equivalent amount.
 - NWCCC will organize Neighborhood CFL Installation Challenge/Contest. The intent is to have the CFLs installed within 3 weeks of the start of the event. Avista may provide cash prizes for first through third finishers. All Neighborhood Councils that complete install project will have additional 500 CFLs available for install if they are interested in doing more installs.
- General Criteria:
 - The Neighborhood Councils will need to submit a written CFL distribution plan. The distribution plan must demonstrate at least a 90% installation rate of the distributed CFL product. The distribution plan must include information on 1) How and by whom the CFLs will be installed, 2) CFL installation tracking mechanism, 3) How the distribution of Avista energy efficiency materials will be handled (Energy Conservation educational materials are required to be distributed by the organization to the recipients of the product) and 4) Verification that the CFLs are being installed into residences that Avista provides electricity.
 - The CFLs are intended for placement at premises within Avista's electric service territory and not to be sold or otherwise distributed.
 - Participating organization must sign this agreement affirming adherence to these policies.
 - This policy is in effect through the remainder of calendar year 2008, unless Avista's policy is terminated or modified prior to that time.
