- A sturdy fence will be erected to establish a tree protection zone.
- Trees will not be used to display signs or support electrical wires.
- Tree trunks and crowns will be protected from construction equipment, building material and waste products.
- Water will be provided for the trees as needed.
- All damaged branches and roots will be pruned carefully.
- Tunneling beneath trees for underground utilities will be attempted.
- Radical grade changes within the tree protection zone will be avoided.
- Existing community of plants will be protected where possible.
